Building Something

The Garden District Home began with a simple idea: a new home should feel as though it has always belonged. Surrounded by historic houses rich with character, we studied the proportions, materials, rooflines, and details that give the neighborhood its sense of place—then designed a home for modern life without losing that connection to the past.

Our favorite compliment came when someone would assume the house was generations old and we would tell them the secret: It's brand new. That moment captured exactly what we hoped to achieve—a home with the comfort and performance of new construction, but with a soul that feels generations old.





A Mountain Kitchen

We believe every home has a language of its own. Before we begin designing, we take the time to listen—to the architecture, the landscape, the light, and the quiet details that give a place its character. At the Alpine House, that meant opening the kitchen to its surroundings, adding an abundance of windows to bring in natural light while framing the views and ever-changing colors beyond.

Designed for Serenity

Natural materials, thoughtful proportions, and quiet, timeless details allow the kitchen to feel at home within its setting. The result feels less like a remodel and more like something that was simply revealed—a warm, refined space designed not around a moment in time, but around the home, the landscape, and the life unfolding between them.



**Before***2025*

This Hayden lakefront kitchen was begging to be opened up. The home had been previously remodeled in the early 2000's by a German Architect. He had enclosed a portion of the outdoor deck and bar and then opened the wall to join it to the conditioned space.

After*2026*

We installed three new steel beams, oversized glass doors, and glass railings to create a brighter, more connected main level—then completed the space with green-certified flooring, new cabinetry, a waterfall-edge island, and a custom dining nook. From 90's Ikea to a truly, show-worthy kitchen.

PRE-CONSTRUCTION & Design

We begin every project, big or small, with pre-construction.

Pre-construction is where ideas become a real, buildable plan.
